



CASE STUDY: MEQUON-THIENSVILLE SCHOOL DISTRICT (K-12) Mequon, WI

PROBLEM: A half hour north of Milwaukee, in the Mequon-Thiensville School District, two-way radios play an important role in helping to keep students, teachers and staff safe.

"We recently had a power outage at two of our schools that put about a thousand elementary and middle school kids in the dark and left us without running water or our voice-over IP phone service," said Kyle Thompson, Director of Buildings and Grounds. "So we turned to our radios and were able to connect five administrators right away, keep everyone calm, evacuate one school and send students from another school home early. The radios were a phenomenal asset."

SOLUTION: Thompson has been partnering with BAYCOM for the past two years to design, implement and support the district's two-way radio system. Today, it includes more than 220 radios across six schools.

"Ours is a complicated system. We had to set up infrastructure, repeaters and antenna systems. And so when it came online, we hoped for the best," said Thompson. "We had one or two glitches—a couple of radios here and there—but the support that we got from BAYCOM to help flush those problems out was great."

RESULTS: Since the system came online, the school district has already expanded its platform to include several more radios and several more user groups—groups Thompson says they didn't even envision needing until they started using the radios.

"I don't think anybody's ever truly satisfied with the level of safety and security they're able to provide. You always want to refine, study, plan and refine again. We're constantly evolving as it relates to safety."
